

Staff Benefits and Opportunities

Free Use of Printer/Fax/Copier – DSPs and clients are welcome to print, send and receive faxes and copy documents during business hours, M-F, 8:30 am - 4 pm.

Free Computer Usage with Internet – DSPs and clients are welcome to use a desktop computer during business hours to do trainings, check email, complete basic on-line needs (please no surfing or questionable websites). First come, first serve. Limit 1 hour at a time.

Emergency Employee Assistance Pay Advance – In order to help with those unexpected emergencies we all face on occasion, employees in good standing may be eligible for up to \$250 in advance pay.

Free Tax Services – At annual tax time, contact the Douglas County Senior Service office to schedule an appointment. Free tax services are available to people of all ages.

Paid Training – Each month DSPs are asked to complete, an 'In-Home Support' digital newsletter and post-test designed for one hour of educational credit. Upon successful completion of the quiz DSPs will receive a certificate and 1 hour of training pay equal to their hourly wage.
